RE: Preliminary injunction on certain steel nails from China for The Stanley Works (Langfang) Fastening Systems Co., Ltd. for the period 08/01/2012 through 07/31/2013 (A-570-909), court number 15-00121

1. On 05/06/2015, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction enjoining liquidation of certain entries which are subject to the antidumping duty order on certain steel nails from the PRC (A-570-909) for the period 08/01/2012 through 07/31/2013.

2. This injunction was issued in connection with court case number 15-00121 and enjoins liquidation of the entries described in paragraph 3 below.

3. Accordingly, until further notice, do not liquidate entries of subject merchandise which

i. were the subject of the administrative determination published as Certain Steel Nails from the People's Republic of China: Final Results of the Antidumping Duty Administrative Review; 2012-2013, 80 Fed. Reg. 18816 (April 8, 2015);

ii. were exported by The Stanley Works (Langfang) Fastening Systems Co., Ltd.;

iii. were entered or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption, during the period August 1, 2012, through July 31, 2013; and

iv. were the subject of liquidation instructions delivered to the U.S. Customs and Border Protection on April 23, 2015, lifting suspension effective April 8, 2015.

Any entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.

4. The injunction applies to the liquidation instructions in message number 5118306, dated 04/28/2015.

5. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to prevent liquidation of any entries subject to the above.

6. Commerce's APO Docket Center was served with the above-referenced injunction on

05/06/2015. Pursuant to the terms of the injunction, no liquidation of the entries covered by the injunction may be made for entries which remain unliquidated as of 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time on 05/06/2015, which is the day on which the Court entered the injunction order on the docket in this case.
