RE: Preliminary injunction on certain new pneumatic off-the-road tires from the People's Republic of China for various parties for the period 09/01/2012 through 08/31/2013 (A-570-912), Ct. No. 15-00136

1. On 05/12/2015, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction (PI) enjoining liquidation of entries identified in paragraph 2 which are subject to the antidumping duty order on certain new pneumatic off-the-road tires from the People's Republic of China (A-570-912) for the period 09/01/2012 through 08/31/2013. This PI was issued in connection with court number 15-00136.

2. This PI enjoins liquidation of entries which: (1) were exported by Guizhou Tyre Co., Ltd./ Guizhou Tyre Import and Export Co., Ltd., Zhongce Rubber Group Company Limited, Weihai Zhongwei Rubber Co., Ltd., or the PRC-wide entity (including Double Coin Holdings Ltd.); (2) are subject to the antidumping administrative review, the final results of which were published as Certain New Pneumatic Off-the-Road Tires From the People's Republic of China, 80 Fed. Reg. 20197 (Dep't Commerce April 15, 2015) (final results of the 2012-2013 antidumping administrative review), as amended by Certain New Pneumatic Off-the-Road Tires from the People's Republic of China: Amended Final Results of Antidumping Duty Administrative Review; 2012-2013, 80 Fed. Reg. 26230 (Dep't Commerce May 7, 2015); (3) were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption, during the period of September 1, 2012, through August 31, 2013; and (4) remain unliquidated as of 5:00 p.m. on 05/12/2015.

3. Effective 05/12/2015 (the date the Court issued the PI), no liquidation may be made for entries referred to in paragraph 2 which remain unliquidated as of 05/12/2015. Any such entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.

4. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to follow the terms of the PI.

5. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by this PI have not yet been issued.
