RE: Correction of message 2146302 dated 05/25/2012 concerning the countervailing duty investigation on certain steel wheels from the People's Republic of China (C-570-974).

1. This is a correction of paragraphs 2 and 3 in message 2146302 dated 05/25/2012.
2. Paragraphs 2 and 3 of message 2146302 dated 05/25/2012, contained incorrect instructions about the dates of suspension of liquidation and the entries covered.
3. Paragraphs 2 and 3 of message 2146302 reads as follows:
 2. On 01/05/2012, Commerce instructed CBP to discontinue suspension of liquidation for countervailing duty purposes on all shipments of subject merchandise entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 01/04/2012, via message number 2005306 dated 01/05/2012. All estimated countervailing duties deposited on entries of the subject merchandise shall be refunded and the bonds or other security released at the time of liquidation.
 3. Notice of the lifting of suspension of liquidation of entries of merchandise entered or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 09/06/2011 through 01/03/2012 occurred with the publication of the ITC's notice of negative final determination of investigation (77 FR 27249, 05/09/2012).
4. Instead, paragraphs 2 and 3 of message number 2146302 dated 05/25/2012 should read as follows:
 2. CBP should discontinue the suspension of liquidation of entries of merchandise which were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 06/08/2011. Entries should be liquidated without regard for countervailing duties. All estimated countervailing duties deposited on entries of the subject merchandise shall be refunded and bonds or other security released at the time of liquidation.
 3. Notice of the lifting of suspension of liquidation of entries of merchandise entered, or withdrawn

from warehouse, for consumption on or after 06/08/2011 occurred with the publication of the ITC's notice of negative final determination of investigation (77 FR 27249, 05/09/2012).
