RE: Preliminary injunction on seamless refined copper pipe and tube from China for Golden Dragon for the period 11/01/12 through 10/31/13 (A-570-964) court number 15-00177

1. On 06/24/2015, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction (PI) enjoining liquidation of entries identified in paragraph 2 which are subject to the antidumping duty order on seamless refined copper pipe and tube from the People's Republic of China (A-570-964) for the period 11/01/2012 through 10/31/2013. This PI was issued in connection with court number 15-00177.

2. This PI enjoins liquidation of entries which were the subject of the administrative review published as Seamless Refined Copper Pipe and Tube from China: Final Results of Antidumping Duty Administrative Review; 2012-2013, 80 Fed. Reg. 32,087 (Dep't Commerce Jun.5, 2015); were exported by Golden Dragon Precise Copper Tube Group, Inc., Hong Kong GD Trading Co., Ltd., and Golden Dragon Holding (Hong Kong) International, Ltd. (collectively, Golden Dragon); and were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption during the period November 1, 2012, through October 31, 2013.

3. Effective 06/24/2015 (the date the Court issued the PI), no liquidation may be made for entries referred to in paragraph 2 which remain unliquidated as of 5pm. Any such entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.

4. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to follow the terms of the PI.

5. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by this PI have not yet been issued.
