RE: Preliminary injunction on fresh garlic from the People's Republic of China for Shenzhen Xinboda Industrial Co., Ltd. for the period 11/01/2012 through 10/31/2013 (A-570-831), court number 15-00179

1. On 07/07/2015, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction (PI) enjoining liquidation of entries identified in paragraph 2 which are subject to the antidumping duty order on fresh garlic from the People's Republic of China (A-570-831) for the period 11/01/2012 through 10/31/2013. This PI was issued in connection with court number 15-00179.
2. This PI enjoins liquidation of entries of fresh garlic from the People's Republic of China (Case No. A-570-831), that:
 1. were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after November 1, 2012 until October 31, 2013;
 2. were the subject of the administrative proceeding published as Fresh Garlic from the People's Republic of China: Final Results and Partial Rescission of the 19th Antidumping Duty Administrative Review 2012-2013, 80 Fed. Reg. 34,141 (June 15, 2015); and
 3. were exported from the People's Republic of China to the United States by Shenzhen Xinboda Industrial Co., Ltd.
3. Effective 07/07/2015 (the date the Court issued the PI), no liquidation may be made for entries referred to in paragraph 2 which remain unliquidated as of 5 p.m. on 07/07/2015. Any such entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to follow the terms of the PI.
5. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by this PI have not yet been issued.
