RE: Temporary restraining order and prelim injunction on PET film, sheet, and strip from PRC for Tianjin Wanhua Co., Ltd. for 11/01/2012 through 10/31/2013 (A-570-924) Court number 15-190

1. On 07/09/2015, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a temporary restraining order (TRO) and on 7/10/2015 the Court issued a preliminary injunction (PI) enjoining liquidation of entries identified in paragraph 2 which are subject to the antidumping duty order on polyethylene terephthalate film, sheet, and strip from the People's Republic of China (A-570-924) for the period 11/01/2012 through 10/31/2013. These documents were issued in connection with court number 15-190.

2. The TRO and PI both enjoin liquidation of entries which were exported by Tianjin Wanhua Co. Ltd. that were subject to the antidumping duty administrative review of Polyethylene Terephthalate Film, Sheet, and Strip From the People's Republic of China: Final Results of the Antidumping Duty Administrative Review; 2012-13, 80 Fed. Reg. 33,241 (June 11, 2014) and that were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption during the period of November 1, 2012 through October 31, 2013.

3. Effective 07/09/2015, pursuant to the terms of the TRO, no liquidation of the entries referred to in paragraph 2 may be made for entries which remain unliquidated as of 07/09/2015. Any such entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.

4. Pursuant to the terms of the PI, no liquidation of the entries referred to in paragraph 2 may be made for entries which remain unliquidated as of 5 pm on 7/17/2015 (the fifth business day after the day the court entered the order on the docket (07/10/2015)).

5. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to follow the terms of the TRO and PI.

6. The TRO and PI apply to the liquidation instructions in message number 5183320, dated 07/02/2015.
