RE: Scope determination on antidumping order on aluminum extrusions from the People's Republic of China (A-570-967).

1. On 07/13/2012, in response to a request by Electrolux North America, Inc., Electrolux Home Products, Inc. and Electrolux Major Appliances ("Electrolux"), Commerce issued a final scope determination that fin evaporator systems ("FESs") which Electrolux imports are within the scope of the antidumping order on aluminum extrusions from the People's Republic of China (A-570-967).
2. Commerce explicitly included within the scope of the aluminum extrusions antidumping ("AD") duty order fin evaporator coils ("FECs") described as subassemblies for refrigeration units made from extruded aluminum tubes of alloy series designation 1 or 3, extruded aluminum coils, with aluminum fins and copper stubs attached (76 FR 30650, 05/26/2011). Because the FESs imported by Electrolux are materially the same as the FECs already determined to be subject to the order, i.e., they are extruded aluminum tubes that are bent and welded together to form a coil, to which fins made of aluminum alloy sheet are attached, followed by the attachment of copper stub fittings, Commerce found that this product is also within the scope of the order.
3. Continue to suspend liquidation of entries of aluminum extrusions from the People's Republic of China, including FESs imported by Electrolux described above, subject to the antidumping order on aluminum extrusions from the People's Republic of China.
