RE: Amended final negative determination of circumvention of antidumping duty order on carbon and certain alloy steel wire rod from Mexico (A-201-830).

1. On 10/01/2012, Commerce published in the Federal Register its notice of an affirmative final determination of circumvention of the antidumping duty order on carbon and certain alloy steel wire rod from Mexico (A-201-830). See 77 FR 59892 and message 2297301, dated 10/23/2012. The products covered by this affirmative circumvention determination are carbon and certain alloy steel wire rod with actual diameters of 4.75 mm to 5.00 mm produced and/or exported to the United States by Deacero S.A. de C.V. or Deacero USA, Inc.
2. On 12/22/2014, the United States Court of International Trade sustained Commerce's negative circumvention determination from the First Remand Results. Therefore, on 07/27/2015, Commerce published in the Federal Register "Carbon and Certain Alloy Steel Wire Rod from Mexico: Notice of Court Decision Not in Harmony With Final Results and Notice of Amended Final Determination" (80 FR 44326) which specified the effective date of the amended determination is 01/01/2015.
3. As a result, effective 01/01/2015, continue to suspend liquidation of entries of carbon and certain alloy steel wire rod from Mexico with actual diameters of 4.75 mm to 5.00 mm produced and/or exported by Deacero S.A. de C.V. or Deacero USA, Inc. (A-201-830-006) that were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 01/01/2015 at a zero cash deposit rate, until further instructions are provided.
4. Instructions for granting a request for a refund on any over collection will be issued in a separate message.
5. Do not liquidate any entries of the merchandise covered by paragraph 3 until specific liquidation instructions are issued.
