RE: Preliminary injunction on steel wire garment hangers from China for Shanghai Wells Hanger Co., Ltd. for the period 10/01/2013 through 09/30/2014 (A-570-918), court number 15-00309

1. On 11/24/2015, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction (PI) enjoining liquidation of entries identified in paragraph 2 which are subject to the antidumping duty order on steel wire garment hangers from the People's Republic of China (A-570-918) for the period 10/01/2013 through 09/30/2014. This PI was issued in connection with court number 15-00309.
2. This PI enjoins liquidation of entries which were exported by Shanghai Wells Hanger Co., Ltd. or Hong Kong Wells Ltd.; and were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, during the period from October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2014.
3. Effective 11/24/2015 (the date the Court issued the PI), no liquidation may be made for entries referred to in paragraph 2 which remain unliquidated as of 5 p.m. on the day after the day when the Court enters this order on the docket in this case. Any such entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to follow the terms of the PI.
5. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by this PI have not yet been issued.
