RE: Automatic liquidation instructions for certain stainless steel sheet and strip from Germany for the period 06/01/1985 through 05/31/1986 (A-428-013)

1. Commerce does not automatically conduct administrative reviews of antidumping duty orders. Instead, reviews must be requested pursuant to section 751(a)(1) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended.
2. Commerce revoked the antidumping duty order on certain stainless steel sheet and strip from Germany for all merchandise exported on or after March 1, 1986 and published the revocation in the Federal Register on 08/11/1986 (51 FR 28738).
3. For the period 06/01/1985 through 05/31/1986, pursuant to CIE message N-2/83, Suppl. #3 and Telex 1818087, dated November 18, 1986, all unliquidated entries of certain stainless steel sheet and strip from Germany exported on or after 03/01/1986 may be appraised without regard to antidumping duties.
4. Commerce did not receive a request for an administrative review of the antidumping duty order on certain stainless steel sheet and strip from Germany for the period 06/01/1985 through 05/31/1986. Therefore, for all other entries of merchandise exported during the period and not covered by paragraph 3 above, assess antidumping duties at the cash deposit or bonding rate in effect on the date of entry:

Product: Certain stainless steel sheet and strip

Country: Germany

Case number: A-428-013

Period: 06/01/1985 through 05/31/1986

5. There are no injunctions applicable to the entries covered by this instruction.
6. These instructions constitute notice of the lifting of suspension of liquidation of entries of subject merchandise covered by paragraph 4. Accordingly, notice of the lifting of suspension occurred on the message date of these instructions.

7. The assessment of antidumping duties by CBP on shipments or entries of this merchandise is subject to the provisions of section 778 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended. Section 778 requires that CBP pay interest on overpayments or assess interest on underpayments of the required amounts deposited as estimated antidumping duties. The interest provisions are not applicable to cash or bonds posted as estimated antidumping duties before the date of publication of the antidumping duty order. Interest shall be calculated from the date payment of estimated antidumping duties is required through the date of liquidation. The rate at which such interest is payable is the rate in effect under section 6621 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 for such period.

8. The regulation at 19 CFR 353.55 covering the reimbursement of antidumping duties went into effect on 02/05/1980 and was in effect during the period covered by these instructions (06/01/1985 through 05/31/1986). The importer was required to file the reimbursement certificate within 30 days after the earlier of: 1) publication of the order or any administrative review thereof pursuant to 19 CFR 353.55 or, if appropriate, 19 CFR 353.49 or 2) importation of the merchandise in a district in which not previously imported. If an importer timely files a protest challenging the presumption of reimbursement and doubling of duties, consistent with CBP's protest process, CBP may accept the reimbursement statement filed with the protest to rebut the presumption of reimbursement.
