RE: Prelim inj on aluminum extrusions from People's Republic of China for Taizhou United Imp. & Exp. Co. Ltd. for period 01/01/2013 thru 12/31/2013 (C-570-968), ct.number 16-00009

1. On 01/15/2016 and 01/20/2016, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction (PI) and amended preliminary injunction, respectively, enjoining liquidation of entries identified in paragraph 2 which are subject to the countervailing duty order on aluminum extrusions from the People's Republic of China (C-570-968) for the period 01/01/2013 through 12/31/2013. This PI was issued in connection with court number 16-00009.

2. This PI enjoins liquidation of unliquidated entries of aluminum extrusions from the People's Republic of China that:

a. Were the subject of the final results of the administrative review in Aluminum Extrusions From the People's Republic of China: Final Results, and Partial Rescission of Countervailing Duty Administrative Review, 2013, 80 Fed. Reg. 77,325 (Dep't Commerce Dec. 14, 2015);

b. Were exported from the People's Republic of China to the United States by Taizhou United Imp. & Exp. Co. Ltd.;

c. Were entered or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption, during the period from January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013, inclusive; and

d. Remain unliquidated as of 5:00 p.m. on the next business day after the day when the Court enters this order on the docket in this case.

3. Effective 01/15/2016 (the date the Court issued the PI), no liquidation may be made for entries referred to in paragraph 2 which remain unliquidated as of 5:00 pm on 01/19/2016, the next business day after the day when the Court entered the order on the docket in this case. Any such entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.

4. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to follow the terms of the PI.

5. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by this PI have not yet been issued.
