RE: Preliminary injunction on tapered roller bearings and parts thereof from the People's Republic of China for Yantai CMC Bearing Co. Ltd. for period 06/01/2013-05/31/2014 (A-570-601), Court # 16-00011

1. On 01/22/2016, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction (PI) enjoining liquidation of entries identified in paragraph 2 which are subject to the antidumping duty order on tapered roller bearings and parts thereof, finished and unfinished, from the People's Republic of China (A-570-601) for the period 06/01/2013 through 05/31/2014. This PI was issued in connection with court number 16-00011.
2. This PI enjoins liquidation of unliquidated entries of tapered roller bearings and parts thereof, finished and unfinished, from the People's Republic of China that were the subject of the administrative determination published as Tapered Roller Bearings and Parts Thereof, Finished and Unfinished, from the People's Republic of China, 81 FR 1396 (Jan. 12, 2016); were produced and exported by Yantai CMC Bearing Co. Ltd.; were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption during the period June 1, 2013, to May 31, 2014; and remain unliquidated as of 5:00 p.m. on January 22, 2016.
3. Effective 01/22/2016 (the date the Court issued the PI), no liquidation may be made for entries referred to in paragraph 2 which remain unliquidated as of 5:00 p.m. on 01/22/2016. Any such entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to follow the terms of the PI.
5. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by this PI have not yet been issued.
