RE: Preliminary injunction on certain activated carbon from China for Ningxia Huahui Activated Carbon Co., Ltd. for the period 04/01/2013 through 03/31/2014 (A-570-904), court number 15-00286

1. On 02/05/2016, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction (PI) enjoining liquidation of entries identified in paragraph 2 which are subject to the antidumping duty order on certain activated carbon from the PRC (A-570-904) for the period 04/01/2013 through 03/31/2014. This PI was issued in connection with court number 15-00286.
2. This PI enjoins liquidation of entries which are subject to the administrative determination published as Certain Activated Carbon From the People's Republic of China: Final Result of Antidumping Duty Administrative Review; 2013-2014, 80 Fed. Reg. 61,172 (Dep't of Commerce Oct. 9, 2015); and were exported from the Peoples Republic of China to the United States by Ningxia Huahui Activated Carbon Co., Ltd. (Huahui) and imported by Global Minerals, Inc.; and remain unliquidated as of 5:00 pm on the fifth business day after the day when the Court enters this order on the docket of this case; and this injunction does not alter the Court's separate injunction issued in Huahui's appeal on October 26, 2015 (ECF 13, Case No. 15-00291).
3. Effective 02/05/2016 (the date the Court issued the PI), no liquidation may be made for entries referred to in paragraph 2 which remain unliquidated as of 5:00 pm on the fifth business day after 02/05/2016. Any such entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to follow the terms of the PI.
5. The PI applies to the liquidation instructions in message number 5348304, dated 12/14/2015.
6.
