RE: Antidumping duty scope determination on Wooden Bedroom Furniture from the People's Republic of China (A-570-890).

Notice of the lifting of suspension occurred on the message date of these instructions. See paragraph 5 below.

1. Commerce received a scope ruling request from Empire Art Direct, LLC. Commerce issued a final scope determination on 02/17/2016 that Empire Art Direct, LLC's Matrix Two Door Accent Console Table (Model CS-002), Red Visioni Two Door Accent Console Table (Model SM-003), and Interlace Gold Leaf Two Door Accent Console Table (Model SM-004) which Empire Art Direct, LLC imports are not within the scope of the antidumping duty order on wooden bedroom furniture from the People's Republic of China (A-570-890).
2. Commerce determined that Empire Art Direct, LLC's Matrix Two Door Accent Console Table (Model CS-002), Red Visioni Two Door Accent Console Table (Model SM-003), and Interlace Gold Leaf Two Door Accent Console Table (Model SM-004) are outside the scope of the order because they do not meet the description of merchandise which is subject to the scope of the order and they are most similar to wooden bookcases and entertainment systems; thus they are excluded from the scope of the order on wooden bedroom furniture from the People's Republic of China. Therefore, Empire Art Direct, LLC's Matrix Two Door Accent Console Table (Model CS-002), Red Visioni Two Door Accent Console Table (Model SM-003), and Interlace Gold Leaf Two Door Accent Console Table (Model SM-004) are not within the scope of the antidumping duty order on wooden bedroom furniture from the People's Republic of China.
3. For all entries of Matrix Two Door Accent Console Tables (Model CS-002), Red Visioni Two Door Accent Console Tables (Model SM-003), and Interlace Gold Leaf Two Door Accent Console Tables (Model SM-004) that remain unliquidated on or after 06/24/2004, CBP shall terminate suspension and liquidate entries of the Matrix Two Door Accent Console Tables (Model CS-002), Red Visioni Two Door Accent Console Tables (Model SM-003), and Interlace Gold Leaf Two Door Accent Console Tables (Model SM-004) which were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption.

4. Refund any cash deposits and release any bonds relating to the console tables described above.
5. These instructions constitute notice of the lifting of suspension of liquidation of entries of Matrix Two Door Accent Console Tables (Model CS-002), Red Visioni Two Door Accent Console Tables (Model SM-003), and Interlace Gold Leaf Two Door Accent Console Tables (Model SM-004) entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 06/24/2004.
6. The assessment of antidumping duties by CBP on shipments or entries of this merchandise is subject to the provisions of section 778 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended. Section 778 requires that CBP pay interest on overpayments or assess interest on underpayments of the required amounts deposited as estimated antidumping duties. The interest provisions are not applicable to cash or bonds posted as estimated antidumping duties before the date of publication of the antidumping duty order. Interest shall be calculated from the date payment of estimated antidumping duties is required through the date of liquidation. The rate at which such interest is payable is the rate in effect under section 6621 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 for such period.
7. Unless instructed otherwise, for all other shipments of wooden bedroom furniture from the People's Republic of China not covered by paragraph 2 above, you shall continue to collect cash deposits of estimated antidumping duties for the merchandise at the current rates.
