RE: Prelim inj on crystalline silicon photovoltaic products from PRC for Jinko Solar for the period 7/31/14 through 1/26/15 and 2/10/15 through 1/31/16 (A-570-010), court # 15-00080

1. On 03/18/2016, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction (PI) enjoining liquidation of entries identified in paragraph 2 which are subject to the antidumping duty order on certain crystalline silicon photovoltaic products from the People's Republic of China (A-570-010) for the periods 7/31/2014 through 1/26/2015 and 2/10/2015 through 1/31/2016. This PI was issued in connection with court number 15-00080.
2. This PI enjoins liquidation of entries, which were exported by either Jinko Solar Co. Ltd. or Jinko Solar Import & Export Co., Ltd., and imported by JinkoSolar (U.S.) Inc.; and were suspended pursuant to Department of Commerce case number A-570-010; and were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption from 7/31/2014 through 1/26/2015 and from 2/10/2015 through 1/31/2016.
3. Effective 03/18/2016, no liquidation may be made for entries referred to in paragraph 2 which remain unliquidated as of 5pm on 03/19/2016. Any such entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to follow the terms of the PI.
5. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by this PI have not yet been issued.
