RE: Preliminary injunction certain new pneumatic off-the-road tires from Peoples Republic of China for Weihai Zhongwei Rubber Co., Ltd. for period 09/01/2013 - 8/31/2014 (A-570-912), court number 16-00084

1. On 05/26/2016, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction (PI) enjoining liquidation of entries identified in paragraph 2 which are subject to the antidumping duty order on certain new pneumatic off-the-road tires from the People's Republic of China (A-570-912) for the period 09/01/2013 through 08/31/2014. This PI was issued in connection with court number 16-00084.
2. This PI enjoins liquidation of entries which were subject to the U.S. Department of Commerce's final results in Certain New Pneumatic Off-the-Road Tires From the People's Republic of China: Final Results of Antidumping Duty Administrative Review; 2013-2014, 81 Fed. Reg. 23,272 (April 20, 2016) ("Final Results"); were exported from the People's Republic of China to the United States by Weihai Zhongwei Rubber Co., Ltd.; were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption between September 1, 2013, through August 31, 2014; and remain unliquidated as of 5:00 p.m. on 05/26/2016.
3. Effective 05/26/2016 (the date the Court issued the PI), no liquidation may be made for entries referred to in paragraph 2 which remain unliquidated as of 5:00 p.m. 05/26/2016. Any such entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to follow the terms of the PI.
5. The PI applies to the liquidation instructions in message number 6130302, dated 05/09/2016.
