RE: Temporary Restraining Order on crystalline silicon photovoltaic products from Taiwan for Neo Solar Power Corporation for the period July 31, 2014 to January 31, 2016 (A-583-853), court # 16-00088

1. On May 27, 2016, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a temporary restraining order (TRO) enjoining liquidation of entries identified in paragraph 2 which are subject to the antidumping duty order on certain crystalline silicon photovoltaic products from Taiwan (A-583-853) for the period July 31, 2014 through January 31, 2016. This TRO was issued in connection with court number 16-00088.
2. This TRO enjoins liquidation of entries of certain crystalline silicon photovoltaic products that: (a) are defined in the scope for the Department of Commerce's antidumping duty order on certain crystalline silicon photovoltaic products from Taiwan, A-583-853; (b) were entered from July 31, 2014 to January 31, 2016; (c) were either exported to or imported into the United States by Neo Solar Power Corporation; and (d) remain unliquidated as of 5:11PM May 26, 2016.
3. Effective 05/27/2016 (the date the Court issued the TRO), no liquidation may be made for entries referred to in paragraph 2 which remain unliquidated as of 5:11P.M. on 05/26/2016. Any such entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to follow the terms of the TRO.
5. The TRO applies to the liquidation instructions in message number 6117311, dated 04/26/2016.
