RE: Preliminary injunction on chlorinated isocyanurates from the People's Republic of China for Arch Chemicals (China) Co., Ltd. for the period 06/01/2011 through 05/31/2012 (A-570-898)

1. On 02/25/2014, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction enjoining liquidation of certain entries which are subject to the antidumping duty order on chlorinated isocyanurates from the People's Republic of China (A-570-898) for the period 06/01/2011 through 05/31/2012.

2. This injunction was issued in connection with court case number 14-00058 and enjoins liquidation of the entries described in paragraph 3 below.

3. Accordingly, until further notice, do not liquidate entries of subject merchandise which were exported from the People's Republic of China to the United States by Arch Chemicals (China) Co., Ltd., and which were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption during the period 06/01/2011 through 05/31/2012. Any entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.

4. The injunction applies to the liquidation instructions in message number 4052327, dated 02/21/2014.

5. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to prevent liquidation of any entries subject to the above.

6. Commerce's APO Docket Center was served with the above-referenced injunction on 02/25/2014. Pursuant to the terms of the injunction, no liquidation of the entries covered by the injunction may be made for entries which remain unliquidated as of 5:00 p.m. on the date of this order after which copies of this order are personally served on Commerce's APO Docket Center.
