RE: Preliminary injunction on Multilayered Wood Flooring from China for Guangdong Yihua Timber Industry Co., Ltd. for the period 12/01/2013 through 11/30/2014 (A-570-970), court number 16-00146

1. On 08/10/2016, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction (PI) enjoining liquidation of entries identified in paragraph 2 which are subject to the antidumping duty order on Multilayered Wood Flooring ("MLWF") from the People's Republic of China (A-570-970) for the period 12/01/2013 through 11/30/2014. This PI was issued in connection with court number 16-00146.
2. This PI enjoins liquidation of entries which (1) were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption during the period December 1, 2013 through November 30, 2014, inclusive; (2) were subject to the antidumping duty administrative review, the final results of which were published as Multilayered Wood Flooring from the People's Republic of China; Final Results of Antidumping Duty Administrative Review; 2013-2014, 81 Fed. Reg. 46,899 (Dep't of Commerce Jul. 19, 2016); (3) were exported by Guangdong Yihua Timber Industry Co., Ltd.; and (4) remain unliquidated as of 5:00p.m. on 8/10/2016.
3. Effective 08/10/2016 (the date the Court issued the PI), no liquidation may be made for entries referred to in paragraph 2 which remain unliquidated as of 5pm 08/10/2016. Any such entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to follow the terms of the PI.
5. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by this PI have not yet been issued.
