RE: Scope determination on antidumping duty order on wooden bedroom furniture from the People's Republic of China (A-570-890).

1. On 08/03/2016, in response to a request by Delta Enterprise Corporation ("Delta"), Commerce issued a final scope determination that five infant changing stations (Model 702040, Model KB 101, Model KB 102, Model KB 103, and Model KB 104) which Delta imports from the People's Republic of China ("PRC") are within the scope of the antidumping duty order on wooden bedroom furniture from the PRC (A-570-890).
2. Because none of the imported changing stations satisfy all of the criterion previously found by Commerce to indicate that a changing table is not subject to the scope of the antidumping duty order on wooden bedroom furniture from the PRC nor are they sufficiently distinguishable from dressers and other wooden bedroom furniture explicitly covered by the scope of the antidumping duty order on wooden bedroom furniture from the PRC, Commerce found these changing stations to be within the scope of the order.
3. Continue to suspend liquidation of entries of wooden bedroom furniture from the PRC, including changing station Model 702040, Model KB 101, Model KB 102, Model KB 103, and Model KB 104 imported by Delta which are subject to the antidumping duty order on wooden bedroom furniture from the PRC.
