RE: Correction of message 4286202, dated 10/12/2004 concerning the countervailing duty order on certain pasta from Turkey (C-489-806)

1. This is a correction to message 4286202, dated 10/12/2004, to include liquidation instructions for all entries from all firms. In addition, paragraphs 6 and 7 of that message have been updated.

2. Paragraph 4 did not include complete liquidation instructions for all shipments of merchandise during the period 01/01/2003 through 12/31/2003. Below is the fully corrected message.

3. The Department of Commerce did not receive a request for an administrative review of the countervailing duty order on certain pasta from Turkey (C-489-806) for the period 01/01/2003 through 12/31/2003.

4. The merchandise covered by these instructions is certain pasta from Turkey (C-489-806) currently provided for under harmonized tariff schedule item number 1902.19.20.

5. Therefore, in accordance with section 351.212(c) of the Commerce regulations, you are to assess countervailing duties at rates equal to the cash deposit of estimated countervailing duties required at the time of entry on the specified subject merchandise exported on or after 01/01/2003 and on or before 12/31/2003.

Product: certain pasta

Country: Turkey

Period: 01/01/2003 through 12/31/2003

Liquidate all entries for all firms.

6. The suspension of liquidation ordered for the merchandise listed above exported on or before 12/31/2003 is lifted.

7. The assessment of countervailing duties by U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) on shipments or entries of this merchandise is subject to the provisions of section 778 of the Tariff Act of 1930. Section 778 requires that CBP pay interest on overpayments or assess interest on

overpayments or assess interest on underpayments, of the required amounts deposited as estimated countervailing duties. The interest provisions are not applicable to cash or bonds posted as estimated countervailing duties before the date of publication of the countervailing duty order. Interest shall be calculated from the entry date or date of deposit whichever is later, or estimated countervailing duties through the date of liquidation. The rate at which such interest is payable is the rate in effect under section 6621 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 for such period.
