RE: Preliminary injunction on xanthan gum from the PRC for Inner for Mongolia Jianlong Biochemical Co., Ltd. for the period 07/01/2014 through 06/30/2015 (A-570-985), court number 16-00187

1. On 10/03/2016, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction (PI) enjoining liquidation of entries identified in paragraph 2 which are subject to the antidumping duty order on xanthan gum from the People's Republic of China (PRC) (A-570-985) for the period 07/01/2014 through 06/30/2015. This PI was issued in connection with court number 16-00187.
2. This PI enjoins liquidation of entries of xanthan gum which were exported by Inner Mongolia Jianlong Biochemical Co., Ltd. from the People's Republic of China to the United States; and; which were subject of the administrative determination in Xanthan Gum From the People's Republic of China; Rescission of 2014-2015 Antidumping Duty New Shipper Review, 81 Fed. Reg. 56,586 (August 22, 2016); and were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption during the period July 1, 2014, through June 30, 2015.
3. Effective 10/03/2016, no liquidation may be made for entries referred to in paragraph 2 which remain unliquidated as of 5:00 p.m. 10/03/2016. Any such entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to follow the terms of the PI.
5. The PI applies to the liquidation instructions in message number 6271306, dated 09/27/2016, and the correction instructions in message 6277301, dated 10/03/2016.
