RE: Antidumping duty scope determination on polyvinyl alcohol from Japan (A-588-861)

Notice of the lifting of suspension occurred on the message date of these instructions. See paragraph 5 below.

1. Commerce received a scope ruling request from Kuraray America Inc. Commerce issued a final scope determination on 10/06/2016 that Kuraray Co., Ltd.'s Kuraray Poval 3-86 SD, when certified for use in a paper application, which Kuraray America Inc. imports, is not within the scope of the antidumping duty order on polyvinyl alcohol from Japan (A-588-861).
2. Commerce determined that imports by Kuraray America Inc. of Kuraray Poval 3-86 SD, when certified for use in a paper application, are outside the scope of the order because Kuraray Poval 3-86 SD meets the specific scope exclusion for polyvinyl alcohol covalently bonded with carboxylic acid uniformly present on all polymer chains in a concentration equal to or greater than two mole percent. Therefore, Kuraray Co., Ltd.'s Kuraray Poval 3-86 SD, which meets the physical description of the scope exclusion, and when certified for use in a paper application, is not within the scope of the antidumping duty order on polyvinyl alcohol from Japan.
3. For all entries of polyvinyl alcohol not within scope that remain unliquidated on or after 02/20/2003 , CBP shall terminate suspension and liquidate entries of product not within scope which were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption.
4. Refund any cash deposits relating to Kuraray Poval 3-86 SD, where the entries are certified for use in a paper application, as described above.
5. These instructions constitute notice of the lifting of suspension of liquidation of unliquidated entries of Kuraray Poval 3-86 SD, when certified for use in a paper application, entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 02/20/2003.

6. The assessment of antidumping duties by CBP on shipments or entries of this merchandise is subject to the provisions of section 778 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended. Section 778 requires that CBP pay interest on overpayments or assess interest on underpayments of the

required amounts deposited as estimated antidumping duties. The interest provisions are not applicable to cash or bonds posted as estimated antidumping duties before the date of publication of the antidumping duty order. Interest shall be calculated from the date payment of estimated antidumping duties is required through the date of liquidation. The rate at which such interest is payable is the rate in effect under section 6621 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 for such period.

7. Unless instructed otherwise, for all other shipments of polyvinyl alcohol from Japan not covered by paragraph 2 above, you shall continue to collect cash deposits of estimated antidumping duties for the merchandise at the current rates.
