RE: Notice of preliminary determination in the countervailing duty investigation of finished carbon steel flanges from India (C-533-872)

1. On 11/29/2016, Commerce published in the Federal Register its affirmative preliminary determination and alignment of its final determination in the countervailing duty investigation of finished carbon steel flanges from India from 02/20/2017 until no later than 04/11/2017, thereby aligning it with the due date for the final determination in the antidumping duty investigation of finished carbon steel flanges from India (81 FR 85928).
2. The products covered by this investigation are described in message 6211305 dated 07/29/2016.
3. This investigation has been assigned investigation number C-533-872.
4. For imports of finished carbon steel flanges from India, CBP shall suspend liquidation of such shipments entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 11/29/2016. Effective 11/29/2016, CBP shall require, for such entries, a cash deposit equal to the subsidy rates for the following companies:
