RE: Preliminary injunction on cut-to-length carbon-quality steel plate from the Republic of Korea for Dongkuk Steel Mill Co., Ltd. POR 01/01/2014 - 12/31/2014 (C-580-837), court nos. 16-00222 and 16-00223

1. On 12/20/2016, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction (PI) enjoining liquidation of entries identified in paragraph 2 which are subject to the countervailing duty order on cut-to-length carbon-quality steel plate from the Republic of Korea (C-580-837) for the period 01/01/2014 through 12/31/2014. This PI was issued in connection with court numbers 16-00222 and 16-00223.
2. This PI enjoins liquidation of entries which 1) were subject to the final results of the administrative review published at Certain Cut-to-Length Steel Plate from the Republic of Korea, 81 FR 64138, September 19, 2016 (final results of countervailing duty administrative review and new shipper review; calendar year 2014); 2) were entered or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, during the period from January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014; 3) were produced and/or exported by Dongkuk Steel Mill Co., Ltd. ("DSM") or Hyundai Steel Corporation ("Hyundai Steel"); and 4) remain unliquidated as of 5:00 p.m. on the fifth business day after the Court enters this order on the docket in this case.
3. Effective 12/20/2016, no liquidation may be made for entries referred to in paragraph 2 which remain unliquidated as of 5:00 p.m. on 12/28/2016. Any such entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to follow the terms of the PI.
5. The PI applies to the liquidation instructions in message numbers 6279307 and 6279308, dated 10/05/2016.
