RE: Preliminary injunction on freshwater crawfish tail meat from the People's Republic of China for Xiping Opeck Food Co., Ltd. (A-570-848), court number 12-00112

1. ON 05/03/2012, THE U.S. COURT OF INTERNATIONAL TRADE ISSUED A PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION ENJOINING LIQUIDATION OF CERTAIN ENTRIES WHICH ARE SUBJECT TO THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER ON FRESHWATER CRAWFISH TAIL MEAT FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA (CHINA) (A-570-848) FOR THE PERIOD 09/01/2009 THROUGH 08/31/2010.

2. THIS INJUNCTION WAS ISSUED IN CONNECTION WITH COURT CASE NUMBER 12-00112 AND ENJOINS LIQUIDATION OF THE ENTRIES DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH 3 BELOW.

3. ACCORDINGLY, UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE, DO NOT LIQUIDATE ENTRIES OF SUBJECT MERCHANDISE WHICH WERE THE SUBJECT OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW PUBLISHED AS FRESHWATER CRAWFISH TAIL MEAT FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA: FINAL RESULTS OF ANTIDUMPING DUTY ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW AND RESCISSION OF REVIEW IN PART, 77 FR 21529 (APR. 10, 2012); WHICH WERE EXPORTED FROM CHINA BY XIPING OPECK FOOD CO., LTD.; WHICH WERE IMPORTED BY OR SOLD TO (AS INDICATED ON THE COMMERCIAL INVOICE OR CUSTOMS DOCUMENTATION) GB IMPORTS & EXPORTS, INC.; AND WHICH WERE ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION DURING THE PERIOD 09/01/2009 THROUGH 08/31/2010. ANY ENTRIES THAT ARE SET FOR LIQUIDATION MUST BE UNSET IMMEDIATELY. CONTINUE TO SUSPEND LIQUIDATION OF THESE ENTRIES UNTIL LIQUIDATION INSTRUCTIONS ARE ISSUED.

4. THE INJUNCTION APPLIES TO THE LIQUIDATION INSTRUCTIONS IN MESSAGE NUMBER 2117309, DATED 04/26/2012.

5. EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, CBP IS INSTRUCTED TO PREVENT LIQUIDATION OF ANY ENTRIES SUBJECT TO THE ABOVE.

6. COMMERCE RECEIVED THE ABOVE-REFERENCED INJUNCTION ON 05/03/2012. PURSUANT TO THE TERMS OF THE INJUNCTION, NO LIQUIDATION OF THE ENTRIES COVERED BY THE INJUNCTION MAY BE MADE FOR ENTRIES WHICH REMAIN UNLIQUIDATED AS OF 05/03/2012.
