RE: Preliminary injunction on aluminum extrusions from the PRC exported by Guangdong Zhongya Aluminum Company Limited for the period 11/12/2010 - 4/30/2012 (A-570-967), court no. 14-00043

1. On 02/11/2014, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction enjoining liquidation of certain entries which are subject to the antidumping duty order on aluminum extrusions from the People's Republic of China (A-570-967) for the period 11/12/2010 through 04/30/2012.
2. This injunction was issued in connection with court case number 14-00043 and enjoins liquidation of the entries described in paragraph 3 below.
3. Accordingly, until further notice, do not liquidate entries of subject merchandise which were exported from the People's Republic of China to the United States by Zhaoqing New Zhongya Aluminum Co., Ltd., a.k.a. Guangdong Zhongya Aluminum Company Limited.; were the subject of the administrative determination published as Aluminum Extrusions From the People's Republic of China: Final Results of Antidumping Duty Administrative Review and Rescission, in Part, 2010/12, 79 FR 96 (January 2, 2014); were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption during the period 11/12/2010 through 04/30/2012; and remain unliquidated as of 02/11/2014. Any entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by the injunction have not yet been issued.
5. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to prevent liquidation of any entries subject to the above.
6. Commerce's APO Docket Center received the above-referenced injunction on 02/12/2014. The injunction does not require service to take effect. Pursuant to the terms of the injunction, no liquidation of the entries covered by the injunction may be made for entries which remain unliquidated as of 02/11/2014.
