RE: Preliminary injunction pure magnesium from China for collapsed entities Tianjin Magnesium International, Co, Ltd or Tianjin Magnesium Metal Co, Ltd pd. 5/1/2011-4/30/2012 (A-570-832) ct no 14-00038

1. On 02/06/2014, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction enjoining liquidation of certain entries which are subject to the antidumping duty order on pure magnesium from the People's Republic of China (A-570-832) for the period 05/01/2011 through 04/30/2012.
2. This injunction was issued in connection with court case number 14-00038 and enjoins liquidation of the entries described in paragraph 3 below.
3. Accordingly, until further notice, do not liquidate entries of subject merchandise which were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption during the period 05/01/2011 through 04/30/2012, inclusive; are subject to the antidumping duty administrative review, the final results of which were published as Pure Magnesium From the People's Republic of China: Final Results of Antidumping Duty Administrative Review; 2011-2012, 79 FR 94 (02/02/2014); and were exported by either of the following collapsed entities: Tianjin Magnesium International, Co., Ltd. or Tianjin Magnesium Metal Co., Ltd. Any entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. The injunction applies to the liquidation instructions in message number 4036303, dated 02/05/2014.
5. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to prevent liquidation of any entries subject to the above.
6. Commerce's APO Docket Center was served with the above-referenced injunction on 02/06/2014. Pursuant to the terms of the injunction, no liquidation of the entries covered by the injunction may be made for entries which remain unliquidated, including entries set or scheduled for liquidation, as of 5:00 p.m. on 02/06/2014.
