RE: LIQUIDATION FOLLOWING ITC NOTIFICATION OF THREAT OF MATERIAL INJURY FOR DRILL PIPE FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA FOR THE PERIOD BEFORE 03/03/2011 (A-570-965)

1. ON 03/03/2011, THE INTERNATIONAL TRADE COMMISSION PUBLISHED IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER (76 FR 11812, DATED 03/03/2011) ITS FINAL DETERMINATION NOTIFYING COMMERCE THAT IMPORTS OF DRILL PIPE FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA THREATEN THE U.S. INDUSTRY WITH MATERIAL INJURY.
2. IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 736(B)(2) OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930, CBP SHOULD TERMINATE THE SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION FOR ALL SHIPMENTS OF DRILL PIPE FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION BEFORE 03/03/2011. ALL ENTRIES OF SUBJECT MERCHANDISE THAT WERE ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR AFTER 05/20/2010 AND ON OR BEFORE 03/02/2011 SHOULD BE LIQUIDATED WITHOUT REGARD TO ANTIDUMPING DUTIES (I.E., RELEASE ALL BONDS AND RETURN ALL CASH DEPOSITS).
3. NOTICE OF THE LIFTING OF SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION OF ENTRIES OF MERCHANDISE ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION BEFORE THE DATE OF PUBLICATION OF THE ITC'S FINAL DETERMINATION NOTICE IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER, OCCURRED WITH THE PUBLICATION OF THE ITC'S FINAL DETERMINATION OF INVESTIGATION (76 FR 11812, DATED 03/03/2011). FOR ALL OTHER SHIPMENTS OF DRILL PIPE FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA, YOU SHALL, UNLESS OTHERWISE INSTRUCTED, CONTINUE TO COLLECT CASH DEPOSITS OF ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES FOR THE MERCHANDISE AT THE CURRENT RATES.
4. INTEREST PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930 DO NOT APPLY.
