RE: Prelim inj on welded carbon steel standard pipe and tube products from Turkey for Borusan Mannesmann Boru Sanayi ve Ticaret A.S. for the period 05/01/2011 thru 04/30/2012 (A-489-501), court# 14-00009

1. On 01/15/2014, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction enjoining liquidation of certain entries which are subject to the antidumping duty order on welded carbon steel standard pipe and tube products from Turkey (A-489-501) for the period 05/01/2011 through 04/30/2012.
2. This injunction was issued in connection with court case number 14-00009 and enjoins liquidation of the entries described in paragraph 3 below.
3. Accordingly, until further notice, do not liquidate entries of subject merchandise which were produced and/or exported by Borusan Mannesmann Boru Sanayi ve Ticaret A.S.; were the subject of the United States Department of Commerce's final determination in Welded Carbon Steel Standard Pipe and Tube Products from Turkey: Final Results of Antidumping Duty Administrative Review; 2011-2012, 78 Fed. Reg. 79,665 (Dep't of Commerce Dec. 31, 2013); and were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption during the period 05/01/2011 through 04/30/2012. Any entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by the injunction have not yet been issued.
5. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to prevent liquidation of any entries subject to the above.
6. Commerce's APO Docket Center received the above-referenced injunction on 01/15/2014. The injunction does not require service to take effect. Pursuant to the terms of the injunction, no liquidation of the entries covered by the injunction may be made for entries which remain unliquidated as of 01/15/2014.
