RE: LIQUIDATION FOLLOWING INTERNATIONAL TRADE COMMISSION NOTIFICATION OF THREAT OF MATERIAL INJURY FOR SEAMLESS REFINED COPPER PIPE AND TUBE FROM MEXICO FOR THE PERIOD BEFORE 11/22/2010 (A-201-838)

1. ON 11/22/2010, THE INTERNATIONAL TRADE COMMISSION (“ITC”) PUBLISHED IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER (75 FR 71146, DATED 11/22/2010) ITS FINAL DETERMINATION NOTIFYING THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE THAT IMPORTS OF SEAMLESS REFINED COPPER PIPE AND TUBE FROM MEXICO THREATEN THE U.S. INDUSTRY WITH MATERIAL INJURY.
2. IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 736(B)(2) OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930, AS AMENDED, CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION (“CBP”) SHOULD TERMINATE THE SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION FOR ALL SHIPMENTS OF SEAMLESS REFINED COPPER PIPE AND TUBE FROM MEXICO ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION BEFORE 11/22/2010. ALL ENTRIES OF SUBJECT MERCHANDISE THAT WERE ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION BEFORE 11/22/2010 SHOULD BE LIQUIDATED WITHOUT REGARD TO ANTIDUMPING DUTIES (I.E., RELEASE ALL BONDS AND RETURN ALL CASH DEPOSITS).
3. NOTICE OF THE LIFTING OF SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION OF ENTRIES OF MERCHANDISE ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION BEFORE 11/22/2010 OCCURRED WITH THE PUBLICATION OF THE ITC’S FINAL DETERMINATION (75 FR 71146, DATED 11/22/2010). FOR ALL OTHER SHIPMENTS OF SEAMLESS REFINED COPPER PIPE AND TUBE FROM MEXICO, YOU SHALL, UNLESS OTHERWISE INSTRUCTED, CONTINUE TO COLLECT CASH DEPOSITS OF ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES FOR THE MERCHANDISE AT THE CURRENT RATES.
4. INTEREST PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930 DO NOT APPLY.
