THIS MESSAGE REPLACES MESSAGE NUMBER 0327305, DATED 11/23/2010, WHICH WAS INADVERTENTLY INACTIVATED.

1. ON 11/17/2010, THE INTERNATIONAL TRADE COMMISSION (ITC) PUBLISHED IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER (75 FR 70289, DATED 11/17/2010) ITS FINAL DETERMINATION NOTIFYING COMMERCE THAT IMPORTS OF CERTAIN COATED PAPER SUITABLE FOR HIGH-QUALITY PRINT GRAPHICS USING SHEET-FED PRESSES (CERTAIN COATED PAPER) FROM INDONESIA THREATEN THE U.S. INDUSTRY WITH MATERIAL INJURY.
2. IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 706(B)(2) OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930, U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION (CBP) SHOULD TERMINATE THE SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION FOR ALL SHIPMENTS OF CERTAIN COATED PAPER FROM INDONESIA ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION BEFORE 11/17/2010. ALL ENTRIES OF SUBJECT MERCHANDISE THAT WERE SUSPENDED BEFORE 11/17/2010 SHOULD BE LIQUIDATED WITHOUT REGARD TO COUNTERVAILING DUTIES (I.E., RELEASE ALL BONDS AND RETURN ALL CASH DEPOSITS).
3. NOTICE OF THE LIFTING OF SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION OF ENTRIES OF MERCHANDISE ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION BEFORE THE DATE OF PUBLICATION OF THE ITC'S FINAL DETERMINATION NOTICE IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER, OCCURRED WITH THE PUBLICATION OF THE ITC'S FINAL DETERMINATION OF INVESTIGATION (75 FR 70289, 11/17/2010). FOR ALL OTHER SHIPMENTS OF CERTAIN COATED PAPER FROM INDONESIA, YOU SHALL, UNLESS OTHERWISE INSTRUCTED, CONTINUE TO COLLECT CASH DEPOSITS OF ESTIMATED COUNTERVAILING DUTIES FOR THE MERCHANDISE AT THE CURRENT RATES.
4. INTEREST PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930 DO NOT APPLY.
