RE: CORRECTION OF MESSAGE 8330207 DATED 11/25/2008 OF CERTAIN NEW PNEUMATIC OFF-THE-ROAD TIRES FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA

1. ON SEPTEMBER 4, 2008 COMMERCE PUBLISHED IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER AND AMENDED FINAL DETERMINATION IN THE INVESTIGATION OF CERTAIN NEW PNEUMATIC OFF-THE-ROAD TIRES FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA. (73 FR 51624) IN THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATION OF A-570-912. THIS IS A CORRECTION OF PARAGRAPH 4 IN MESSAGE 8330207, DATED 11/25/2008.

2. IN PARAGRAPH 4 OF MESSAGE 8330207, THE DEPARTMENT ERRONEOUSLY INSTRUCTED CBP TO REFUND ALL CASH DEPOSITS AND RELEASE ALL BONDS COLLECTED ON OR AFTER NOVEMBER 22, 2007, AND BEFORE JULY 15, 2008. THE DATE OF JULY 15, 2008 REPRESENTS THE PUBLICATION OF THE FINAL DETERMINATION. HOWEVER, THE CORRECT DATE SHOULD HAVE BEEN THE PUBLICATION OF THE PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION (FEBRUARY 20, 2008).

3. PARAGRAPH 4 OF MESSAGE 8330207 CURRENTLY READS AS FOLLOWS:

THE U.S. INTERNATIONAL TRADE COMMISSION DETERMINED THAT CRITICAL CIRCUMSTANCES DO NOT EXIST WITH RESPECT TO SUBJECT IMPORTS FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA. AS A RESULT OF THE COMMISSION'S NEGATIVE CRITICAL CIRCUMSTANCES DETERMINATION, CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION WILL REFUND ALL CASH DEPOSITS AND RELEASE ALL BONDS COLLECTED ON CERTAIN NEW PNEUMATIC OFF-THE-ROAD TIRES FROM THE PRC ENTERED OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR AFTER NOVEMBER 22, 2007, AND BEFORE JULY 15, 2008. INTEREST PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930 DO NOT APPLY.

4. INSTEAD, PARAGRAPH 4 OF MESSAGE NUMBER 8330207 SHOULD READ AS FOLLOWS:

THE U.S. INTERNATIONAL TRADE COMMISSION DETERMINED THAT CRITICAL CIRCUMSTANCES DO NOT EXIST WITH RESPECT TO SUBJECT IMPORTS FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA. AS A RESULT OF THE COMMISSION'S NEGATIVE CRITICAL CIRCUMSTANCES DETERMINATION, CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION WILL REFUND ALL CASH DEPOSITS AND RELEASE ALL BONDS COLLECTED ON CERTAIN NEW PNEUMATIC OFF-THE-ROAD TIRES FROM THE PRC ENTERED OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR AFTER NOVEMBER 22, 2007, AND BEFORE FEBRUARY 20, 2008. INTEREST PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930 DO NOT APPLY.
