1. AS A RESULT OF A NOTIFICATION FROM PETITIONERS, THE AMERICAN FURNITURE MANUFACTURERS COMMITTEE FOR LEGAL TRADE AND ITS INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS, THAT THEY ARE NO LONGER INTERESTED IN CHEVAL STYLE MIRRORED JEWELRY CABINETS, SUBJECT TO THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER ON WOODEN BEDROOM FURNITURE FROM THE PRC, THE DEPARTMENT

OF COMMERCE HAS REVOKED THIS ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER IN PART WITH RESPECT TO CHEVAL STYLE MIRRORED JEWELRY CABINETS AND PUBLISHED

THE REVOCATION IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER, 72 FR 948, ON JANUARY 9, 2007.

2. THEREFORE, U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION ("CBP") IS DIRECTED TO TERMINATE THE SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION FOR ALL SHIPMENTS OF CHEVAL STYLE MIRRORED JEWELRY CABINETS, ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR AFTER JANUARY 9,

2007. ALL ENTRIES OF CHEVAL STYLE MIRRORED JEWELRY CABINETS THAT WERE SUSPENDED ON OR AFTER JANUARY 9, 2007 SHOULD BE LIQUIDATED WITHOUT REGARD TO ANTIDUMPING DUTIES (I.E., RELEASE ALL BONDS AND REFUND ALL CASH DEPOSITS).

3. THE ASSESSMENT OF ANTIDUMPING DUTIES BY CBP ON ENTRIES OF THIS MERCHANDISE IS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT 1930. SECTION 778 REQUIRES THAT CBP PAYS INTEREST ON OVERPAYMENTS AND ASSESS INTEREST ON UNDERPAYMENTS OF

THE REQUIRED AMOUNTS DEPOSITED AS ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES. THE INTEREST PROVISIONS ARE NOT APPLICABLE TO CASH OR BONDS POSTED AS ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES BEFORE THE DATE OF PUBLICATION OF THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER. INTEREST SHALL BE CALCULATED FROM THE DATE OF PAYMENT OF ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING

DUTIES THROUGH THE DATE OF LIQUIDATION. THE RATE AT WHICH SUCH INTEREST IS PAYABLE IS THE RATE IN EFFECT UNDER SECTION 6621 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1954 FOR SUCH PERIOD.
