RE: Amended Preliminary injunction on Certain Frozen Fish Fillets from the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (A-552-801), court number 13-00141

1. On 4/17/2013, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction enjoining liquidation of certain entries which are subject to the antidumping duty order on certain frozen fish fillets from the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (A-552-801), for the period 8/1/2010 through 7/31/2011. See Message 3109305, dated 4/19/2013.
2. On 11/22/2013, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued an amended preliminary injunction enjoining liquidation of certain entries which are subject to the antidumping duty order on certain frozen fish fillets from the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (A-552-801), for the period 8/1/2010 through 7/31/2011.
3. The amended preliminary injunction was issued in connection with court case number 13-00141, and enjoins liquidation of the entries described in paragraph 4 below.
4. Accordingly, until further notice, do not liquidate entries of subject merchandise which were exported by QVD Food Company Ltd. or either of its affiliates, QVD Dong Thap Food Co., Ltd. and Thuan Hung Co., Ltd., or which were produced and exported by Asia Commerce Fisheries Joint Stock Company, Cadovimex II Seafood Import-Export and Processing Joint Stock Company, NTSF Seafoods Joint Stock Company, or Saigon Mekong Fishery Co., Ltd., and which were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption during the period 8/1/2010 through 7/31/2011. Any entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
5. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to prevent liquidation of any entries covered by paragraph 4 above, until you receive the applicable liquidation instructions.
6. Liquidation instructions will follow for entries that are no longer affected by this amended preliminary injunction.

Pursuant to the terms of the amended preliminary injunction, no liquidation of the entries covered by amended preliminary injunction may be made for entries which remain unliquidated as of 04/17/2013.
