RE: Preliminary injunction on corrosion resistant carbon steel flat products from Korea for Dongbu Steel Co., Ltd. for the period 08/01/2011 through 02/14/2012 (A-580-816), court number 14-00098

1. On 04/15/2014, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction enjoining liquidation of certain entries which are subject to the antidumping duty order on corrosion resistant carbon steel flat products from Korea (A-580-816) for the period 08/01/2011 through 02/14/2012.
2. This injunction was issued in connection with court case number 14-00098 and enjoins liquidation of the entries described in paragraph 3 below.
3. Accordingly, until further notice, do not liquidate entries of subject merchandise which were produced and exported by Dongbu Steel Co., Ltd., and which were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, during the period from 08/01/2011 through 02/14/2012. Any entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by the injunction have not yet been issued.
5. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to prevent liquidation of any entries subject to the above.
6. Pursuant to the terms of the injunction, no liquidation of the entries covered by the injunction may be made for entries which remain unliquidated as of 04/15/2014.
