RE: Preliminary injunction on helical spring lock washers from the PRC for United Steel and Fasteners, Inc. for the period 10/01/2011 through 09/30/2013 (A-570-822), court number 13-00270

1. On 11/15/2013, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction enjoining liquidation of certain entries which are subject to the antidumping duty order on helical spring lock washers from the People's Republic of China (A-570-822) for the period 10/01/2011 through 09/30/2013.

2. This injunction was issued in connection with court case number 13-00270 and enjoins liquidation of the entries described in paragraph 3 below.

3. Accordingly, until further notice, do not liquidate entries of AREMA (American Railroad Engineering and Maintenance of Way Association) Washers from the People's Republic of China that: (1) are subject to the U.S. Department of Commerce's final scope ruling on 07/10/2013 (see message number 3200310, dated 07/19/2013, and note below); (2) were imported by United Steel and Fasteners, Inc.; and (3) were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption between 10/01/2011 through 09/30/2013. Any entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.

NOTE: Message number 3200310, dated 07/19/2013, erroneously identified the date of Commerce's scope ruling as 07/08/2013. The scope ruling was dated 07/10/2013.

4. The injunction applies to the liquidation instructions in message number 2355303, dated 12/20/2012, for merchandise entered between 10/01/2011 through 09/30/2012. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by the injunction for the period 10/01/2012 through 09/30/2013 have not yet been issued.

5. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to prevent liquidation of any entries subject to the above.

6. Commerce's APO Docket Center received the above-referenced injunction on 11/15/2013.

The injunction does not require service to take effect. Pursuant to the terms of the injunction, no liquidation of the entries covered by the injunction may be made for entries which remain unliquidated as of 11/15/2013.
