RE: Scope determination on antidumping duty order on furfuryl alcohol from the People's Republic of China (A-570-835).

1. On 11/14/2013, in response to a request by PennAKem LLC, Commerce issued a final scope determination that furfuryl alcohol to which up to 0.3 percent of silane by volume has been added prior to importation (i.e., a mixture of furfuryl alcohol and silane, of which the silane component comprises no more than 0.3 percent of the total volume of the blend), including but not limited to products with the trade name "Faint S," is within the scope of the antidumping duty order on furfuryl alcohol from the People's Republic of China (A-570-835).

2. Because the amount of the silane additive is well below the approximate industry standard purity level (namely as much as two percent by volume) discussed in the International Trade Commission's final report for the initial investigation, Commerce does not find that the blending of 0.3 percent of silane coupling compound additive into furfuryl alcohol is sufficient to exclude a product from the scope of the antidumping duty order.

3. Continue to suspend liquidation of entries of furfuryl alcohol from the People's Republic of China, including furfuryl alcohol to which up to 0.3 percent of silane by volume has been added prior to importation described above (including, but not limited to, the "Faint S" products imported by ASK Chemicals GmbH identified in PennAKem's LLC's scope request), subject to the antidumping duty order on furfuryl alcohol from the People's Republic of China.
