1. ON 08/03/2007, THE U.S. COURT OF INTERNATIONAL TRADE (CIT)
ISSUED A FINAL DECISION IN THE CASE OF CHANGCHUN PILKINGTON
SAFETY GLASS COMPANY LIMITED V UNITED STATES, 02-00312. AS A
RESULT OF THIS DECISION, THE CASE DISSOLVED ON 08/03/2007.

2. PURSUANT TO THE UNDERLYING DECISION, THE DEPARTMENT OF
COMMERCE HAS DETERMINED THAT SHENZHEN BENXUN AUTOMOTIVE GLASS

CO., LTD. (A-570-867-003) AND ITS SUCCESSOR-IN-INTEREST,

SHENZHEN CSG AUTOMOTIVE GLASS CO. LTD. (A-570-867-003), ARE EXCLUDED FROM THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER ON AUTOMOTIVE REPLACEMENT GLASS WINDSHIELDS FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA ("PRC"). ACCORDINGLY, FOR AUTOMOTIVE REPLACEMENT GLASS WINDSHIELDS MANUFACTURED/EXPORTED BY SHENZHEN BENXUN AUTOMOTIVE

GLASS CO., LTD., OR ITS SUCCESSOR-IN-INTEREST, SHENZHEN CSG AUTOMOTIVE GLASS CO. LTD., U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION ("CBP") IS DIRECTED TO TERMINATE THE SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION.

FURTHER, FOR ALL SHIPMENTS OF MERCHANDISE MANUFACTURED/EXPORTED

BY SHENZHEN BENXUN AUTOMOTIVE GLASS CO., LTD. OR ITS SUCCESSOR-IN-INTEREST, SHENZHEN CSG AUTOMOTIVE GLASS CO. LTD. AND ENTERED OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR AFTER AUGUST

3, 2007, CBP IS DIRECTED TO RELEASE ANY BOND OR OTHER SECURITY AND REFUND ANY CASH DEPOSIT.

3. NOTICE OF THE LIFTING OF SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION OF ENTRIES OF SUBJECT MERCHANDISE ON OR AFTER 08/03/2007 OCCURRED WITH THE PUBLICATION OF THE AMENDED FINAL RESULTS OF ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW 72 FR 70294, 12/11/2007. FOR ALL OTHER SHIPMENTS OF AUTOMOTIVE REPLACEMENT GLASS WINDSHIELDS FROM THE PRC YOU SHALL,

UNLESS OTHERWISE INSTRUCTED, CONTINUE TO COLLECT CASH DEPOSITS OF ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES FOR THE MERCHANDISE AT THE CURRENT RATES.

4. THE ASSESSMENT OF ANTIDUMPING DUTIES BY CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION ON ENTRIES OF THIS MERCHANDISE IS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930. SECTION 778 REQUIRES THAT CBP PAY INTEREST ON OVERPAYMENTS AND ASSESS INTEREST ON UNDERPAYMENTS OF THE REQUIRED AMOUNTS DEPOSITED AS ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES. THE INTEREST PROVISIONS ARE NOT APPLICABLE TO CASH OR BONDS POSTED AS ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES BEFORE THE DATE OF PUBLICATION OF THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER. INTEREST SHALL BE CALCULATED FROM THE DATE PAYMENT OF ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES IS REQUIRED THROUGH THE DATE OF

LIQUIDATION. THE RATE AT WHICH SUCH INTEREST IS PAYABLE IS THE RATE IN EFFECT UNDER SECTION 6621 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1954 FOR SUCH PERIOD.
