RE: NOTICE OF A PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION IN AN ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATION OF RAW FLEXIBLE MAGNETS FROM TAIWAN (A-583-842-000 THROUGH -003)

1. ON APRIL 25, 2008, THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE PUBLISHED IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER ITS PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF SALES AT LESS THAN FAIR VALUE IN THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATION OF RAW FLEXIBLE MAGNETS FROM TAIWAN.

2. THE PRODUCTS COVERED BY THIS INVESTIGATION ARE CERTAIN FLEXIBLE MAGNET SHEETING, STRIPS, AND PROFILE SHAPES. SUBJECT FLEXIBLE MAGNET SHEETING, STRIPS, AND PROFILE SHAPES ARE BONDED

MAGNETS COMPOSED (NOT NECESSARILY EXCLUSIVELY) OF (I) ANY ONE OR COMBINATION OF VARIOUS FLEXIBLE BINDERS (SUCH AS POLYMERS OR CO-POLYMERS, OR RUBBER) AND (II) A MAGNETIC ELEMENT, WHICH MAY CONSIST OF A FERRITE PERMANENT MAGNET MATERIAL (COMMONLY, STRONTIUM OR BARIUM FERRITE, OR A COMBINATION OF THE TWO) A METAL ALLOY (SUCH AS NDFEB OR ALNICO), ANY COMBINATION OF THE FOREGOING WITH EACH OTHER OR ANY OTHER MATERIAL, OR ANY OTHER MATERIAL CAPABLE OF BEING PERMANENTLY MAGNETIZED. SUBJECT FLEXIBLE MAGNET SHEETING, STRIPS, AND PROFILE SHAPES ARE CAPABLE OF BEING PERMANENTLY MAGNETIZED, BUT MAY BE IMPORTED IN EITHER MAGNETIZED OR UNMAGNETIZED (INCLUDING DEMAGNETIZED) CONDITION. SUBJECT MERCHANDISE MAY BE OF ANY COLOR AND MAY OR MAY NOT BE LAMINATED OR BONDED WITH PAPER, PLASTIC, OR OTHER MATERIAL, WHICH PAPER, PLASTIC, OR OTHER MATERIAL MAY BE OF ANY COMPOSITION AND/OR COLOR. SUBJECT MERCHANDISE MAY BE UNCOATED OR MAY BE COATED WITH AN ADHESIVE OR ANY OTHER COATING OR COMBINATION OF COATINGS. SUBJECT MERCHANDISE IS WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THIS INVESTIGATION WHETHER IT IS IN ROLLS, COILS, SHEETS, OR PIECES, AND REGARDLESS OF PHYSICAL DIMENSIONS OR PACKAGING, INCLUDING SPECIALTY PACKAGING SUCH AS DIGITAL PRINTER CARTRIDGES.

SPECIFICALLY EXCLUDED FROM THE SCOPE OF THIS INVESTIGATION IS RETAIL PRINTED FLEXIBLE MAGNET SHEETING, DEFINED AS FLEXIBLE MAGNET SHEETING (INCLUDING INDIVIDUAL MAGNETS) THAT IS LAMINATED WITH PAPER, PLASTIC OR OTHER MATERIAL, IF SUCH PAPER, PLASTIC, OR OTHER MATERIAL BEARS PRINTED TEXT AND/OR IMAGES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO BUSINESS CARDS, CALENDERS, POETRY, SPORTS EVENT SCHEDULES, BUSINESS PROMOTIONS, DECORATIVE MOTIFS, AND THE LIKE. THIS EXCLUSION DOES NOT APPLY TO SUCH PRINTED FLEXIBLE MAGNET SHEETING IF THE PRINTING CONCERNED CONSISTS OF ONLY THE FOLLOWING:

TRADEMARK OR TRADE NAME; COUNTRY OF ORIGIN; BORDER, STRIPES, OR LINES; ANY PRINTING THAT IS REMOVED IN THE COURSE OF CUTTING AND/OR PRINTING MAGNETS FOR RETAIL SALE OR OTHER DISPOSITION FROM THE FLEXIBLE MAGNET SHEETING; MANUFACTURING USE INSTRUCTIONS (E.G., "PRINT THIS SIDE UP," "THIS SIDE UP.")

"LAMINATE HERE"); PRINTING ON ADHESIVE BACKING (THAT IS, MATERIAL TO BE REMOVED IN ORDER TO EXPOSE ADHESIVE FOR USE, SUCH AS APPLICATION OF LAMINATE) OR ON ANY OTHER COVERING THAT IS REMOVED FROM THE FLEXIBLE MAGNET SHEETING PRIOR OR SUBSEQUENT TO FINAL PRINTING AND BEFORE USE; NON-PERMANENT PRINTING (THAT IS, PRINTING IN A MEDIUM THAT FACILITATES EASY REMOVAL, PERMITTING THE FLEXIBLE MAGNET SHEETING TO BE RE-PRINTED); PRINTING ON THE BACK (MAGNETIC)-SIDE; OR ANY COMBINATION OF THE ABOVE.

ALL PRODUCTS MEETING THE PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF SUBJECT MERCHANDISE THAT ARE NOT SPECIFICALLY EXCLUDED ARE INCLUDED IN THIS SCOPE. THE PRODUCTS SUBJECT TO THE INVESTIGATION ARE CURRENTLY CLASSIFIABLE PRINCIPALLY UNDER SUBHEADINGS 8505.19.10 AND 8505.19.20 OF THE HARMONIZED TARIFF SCHEDULE OF THE UNITED STATES (HTSUS). THE HTSUS SUBHEADINGS ARE PROVIDED ONLY FOR CONVENIENCE AND CUSTOMS PURPOSES. THE WRITTEN DESCRIPTION OF THE SCOPE OF THIS PROCEEDING IS DISPOSITIVE.

3. FOR FURTHER REPORTING PURPOSES THIS CASE HAS BEEN ASSIGNED INVESTIGATION NUMBER A-583-842.

4. FOR IMPORTS OF RAW FLEXIBLE MAGNETS FROM TAIWAN, U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION (CBP) SHALL SUSPEND LIQUIDATION OF SUCH SHIPMENTS ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION

ON OR AFTER APRIL 25, 2008. EFFECTIVE APRIL 25, 2008, CBP SHALL REQUIRE, FOR SUCH ENTIRES, A CASH DEPOSIT OR THE POSTING OF A BOND EQUAL TO THE PERCENTAGE MARGINS SHOWN BELOW.

5. IF ANY ENTRIES OF THIS MERCHANDISE ARE EXPORTED BY A FIRM OTHER THAN THE MANUFACTURER, THEN THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS APPLY:

A. IF THE EXPORTER OF THE SUBJECT MERCHANDISE DOES NOT HAVE ITS OWN RATE BUT THE MANUFACTURER HAS ITS OWN RATE, THE CASH DEPOSIT OR BONDING RATE WILL BE THE MANUFACTURER'S RATE.

B. WHERE NEITHER THE EXPORTER NOR THE MANUFACTURER CURRENTLY HAS ITS OWN RATE OR THE MANUFACTURER IS UNKNOWN, USE THE ALL-OTHER RATE OF 31.20 PERCENT TO ESTABLISH THE CASH DEPOSIT OR BONDING RATE.

6. IN ACCORDANCE WITH T.D. 85-145, AT THE DISCRETION OF CBP, CUSTOMS OFFICERS MAY ACCEPT EITHER A SINGLE-ENTRY BASIC IMPORTATION AND ENTRY BOND OR A CONTINUOUS BASIC IMPORTATION AND ENTRY BOND ONLY IF THE AMOUNT OF THE ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING OR COUNTERVAILING DUTY IS LESS THAN FIVE PERCENT AD VALOREM (OR THE EQUIVALENT). OTHERWISE, WHERE THE IMPORTER HAS THE OPTION TO POST A BOND FOR ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING OR COUNTERVAILING DUTIES, CUSTOMS OFFICERS MUST REQUIRE A SINGLE-ENTRY BASIC IMPORTATION AND ENTRY BOND PURSUANT TO T.D. 85-145. YOU ARE INSTRUCTED TO ADHERE TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF T.D. 85-145 WITH RESPECT TO THESE BONDING REQUIREMENTS.
