RE: NOTICE OF FINAL DETERMINATION IN THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATION OF GLYCINE FROM INDIA (A-533-845-000 THROUGH -012)

1. ON MARCH 28, 2008, THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE PUBLISHED IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER ITS FINAL DETERMINATION OF SALES AT LESS THAN FAIR VALUE IN THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATION OF GLYCINE FROM INDIA.

2. THE MERCHANDISE COVERED BY THIS INVESTIGATION IS GLYCINE, WHICH IN ITS SOLID (i.e., CRYSTALLIZED) FORM IS A FREEFLOWING CRYSTALLINE MATERIAL. GLYCINE IS USED AS A SWEETENER/TASTE ENHANCER, BUFFERING AGENT, REABSORBABLE AMINO ACID, CHEMICAL

INTERMEDIATE, METAL COMPLEXING AGENT, DIETARY SUPPLEMENT, AND IS USED IN CERTAIN PHARMACEUTICALS. THE SCOPE OF THIS INVESTIGATION COVERS GLYCINE IN ANY FORM AND PURITY LEVEL. ALTHOUGH GLYCINE BLENDED WITH OTHER MATERIALS IS NOT COVERED BY THE SCOPE OF THIS INVESTIGATION, GLYCINE TO WHICH RELATIVELY SMALL QUANTITIES OF OTHER MATERIALS HAVE BEEN ADDED IS COVERED BY THE SCOPE. GLYCINE'S CHEMICAL COMPOSITION IS C<sub>2</sub>H<sub>5</sub>NO<sub>2</sub> AND IS NORMALLY CLASSIFIED UNDER SUBHEADING 2922.49.4020 OF THE HARMONIZED TARIFF SCHEDULE OF THE UNITED STATES (HTSUS). THE SCOPE OF THIS INVESTIGATION ALSO COVERS PRECURSORS OF DRIED CRYSTALLINE GLYCINE, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, GLYCINE SLURRY (i.e., GLYCINE IN A NONCRYSTALLIZED FORM) AND SODIUM GLYCINATE. GLYCINE SLURRY IS CLASSIFIED UNDER THE SAME HTSUS SUBHEADING AS CRYSTALLIZED GLYCINE (HTSUS 2922.49.4020) AND SODIUM GLYCINATE IS CLASSIFIED UNDER SUBHEADING HTSUS 2922.49.8000. WHILE HTSUS SUBHEADINGS ARE PROVIDED FOR CONVENIENCE AND CUSTOMS PURPOSES, THE WRITTEN DESCRIPTION OF THE SCOPE OF THIS INVESTIGATION IS DISPOSITIVE.

3. FOR FURTHER REPORTING PURPOSES, THIS CASE HAS BEEN ASSIGNED INVESTIGATION NUMBER A-533-845.

4. FOR IMPORTS OF GLYCINE FROM INDIA MANUFACTURED AND/OR EXPORTED BY PARAS INTERMEDIATES LTD. (A-533-845-001), CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION (CBP) SHALL START TO SUSPEND LIQUIDATION OF SUCH SHIPMENTS ENTERED OR WITHDRAWN FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR AFTER MARCH 28, 2008. CBP SHALL REQUIRE A CASH DEPOSIT OR THE POSTING OF A BOND FOR SUCH ENTRIES EQUAL TO 10.90 PERCENT.

5. FOR IMPORTS OF GLYCINE FROM INDIA NOT MANUFACTURED AND/OR EXPORTED BY PARAS INTERMEDIATES LTD. (A-533-845-001), CBP SHALL CONTINUE TO SUSPEND LIQUIDATION OF SUCH SHIPMENTS ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR AFTER MARCH 28, 2008. CBP SHALL REQUIRE A CASH DEPOSIT OR THE POSTING OF A BOND EQUAL TO THE PERCENTAGE MARGINS SHOWN BELOW.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH T.D. 85-145, AT THE DISCRETION OF CBP, CUSTOMS OFFICERS MAY ACCEPT EITHER A SINGLE-ENTRY BASIC IMPORTATION AND ENTRY BOND OR A CONTINUOUS BASIC IMPORTATION AND ENTRY BOND ONLY ONLY IF THE AMOUNT OF THE ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING OR COUNTERVAILING DUTY IS LESS THAN FIVE PERCENT AD VALOREM (OR THE EQUIVALENT). OTHERWISE, WHERE THE IMPORTER HAS THE OPTION TO POST A BOND FOR ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING OR COUNTERVAILING DUTIES, CUSTOMS OFFICERS MUST REQUIRE A SINGLE-ENTRY BASIC IMPORTATION AND ENTRY BOND PURSUANT TO T.D. 85-145. YOU ARE INSTRUCTED TO ADHERE TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF T.D. 85-145 WITH RESPECT TO THESE BONDING REQUIREMENTS.
