RE: Termination of suspension of liquidation in antidumping duty investigation of hardwood and decorative plywood from the People's Republic of China (A-570-986)

1. In accordance with section 733(d) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, Commerce ordered the suspension of liquidation of entries of merchandise subject to an antidumping duty investigation and shall order the collection of estimated duties for a temporary period (the provisional measures period). On 10/29/2013, the provisional measures period expired.
2. Accordingly, Commerce is instructing CBP to discontinue the suspension of liquidation of entries concerning the antidumping duty investigation of hardwood and decorative plywood from the People's Republic of China effective 10/30/ 2013.
3. The products covered by this investigation are described in message 3269304, dated 09/26/2013.
4. This investigation has been assigned investigation number A-570-986.
5. CBP shall discontinue the suspension of liquidation for antidumping duty purposes on all shipments of subject merchandise entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 10/30/2013. The suspension of liquidation will not be resumed unless and until the final determination on this case is published in the Federal Register by the ITC. CBP shall continue to suspend liquidation on all shipments entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption made during the period 05/03/2013 through 10/29/2013.
6. The suspension of liquidation of entries concerning the companion countervailing duty investigation of hardwood and decorative plywood from the People's Republic of China was discontinued effective 7/12/2013, see message 3196301, dated 07/15/2013.
