RE: GAP PERIOD LIQUIDATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER ON ELECTROLYTIC MANGANESE DIOXIDE FROM AUSTRALIA (A-602-806)

1. IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 733(d) OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930, AS AMENDED, THE COMMERCE DEPARTMENT MAY INSTRUCT CBP TO SUSPEND

THE LIQUIDATION OF ENTRIES OF MERCHANDISE SUBJECT TO AN ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATION AND COLLECT ESTIMATED DUTIES FOR A TEMPORARY PERIOD (THE PROVISIONAL MEASURES PERIOD). WHEN ENTRIES OF SUBJECT MERCHANDISE CONTINUE TO BE SUSPENDED AFTER THE PROVISIONAL MEASURES PERIOD, COMMERCE MUST INSTRUCT CBP TO TERMINATE SUSPENSION AND LIQUIDATE WITHOUT REGARD TO

ANTIDUMPING DUTIES ON SUCH MERCHANDISE.

2. ON 09/22/2008, THE PROVISIONAL MEASURES PERIOD FOR THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATION ON ELECTROLYTIC MANGANESE DIOXIDE FROM AUSTRALIA EXPIRED. SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION OF ENTRIES OF SUBJECT MERCHANDISE MAY HAVE CONTINUED ON OR AFTER THAT DATE.

3. ACCORDINGLY, FOR SHIPMENTS OF ELECTROLYTIC MANGANESE DIOXIDE FROM AUSTRALIA (A-602-806) ENTERED OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE FOR CONSUMPTION DURING THE PERIOD 09/22/2008 THROUGH 10/09/2008, CBP SHOULD TERMINATE THE SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION AND LIQUIDATE SUCH ENTRIES WITHOUT REGARD TO ANTIDUMPING DUTIES (I.E., RELEASE ALL BONDS AND REFUND ALL CASH DEPOSITS).

4. INTEREST PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930 DO NOT APPLY.

5. THIS INSTRUCTION CONSTITUTES NOTICE OF THE LIFTING OF SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION OF ENTRIES OF SUBJECT MERCHANDISE DURING THE PERIOD 09/22/2008 THROUGH 10/09/2008.
