1. ON 05/02/2007, THE U.S. COURT OF INTERNATIONAL TRADE ISSUED A PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION ENJOINING LIQUIDATION OF CERTAIN ENTRIES WHICH ARE SUBJECT TO THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER ON HARD RED SPRING WHEAT FROM CANADA (A-122-847), EXPORTED TO OR IMPORTED INTO THE UNITED STATES BY THE CANADIAN WHEAT BOARD FOR THE PERIOD 05/08/2003 THROUGH 01/01/2006.

2. THIS INJUNCTION WAS ISSUED IN CONNECTION WITH COURT CASE NUMBER 07-00058 AND ENJOINS LIQUIDATION OF THE ENTRIES DESCRIBED ABOVE.

3. ACCORDINGLY, UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE, DO NOT LIQUIDATE ENTRIES OF SUBJECT MERCHANDISE WHICH WERE EXPORTED TO OR IMPORTED INTO THE UNITED STATES BY THE CANADIAN WHEAT BOARD AND WHICH WERE ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION DURING THE PERIOD 05/08/2003 THROUGH 01/01/2006.

4. THIS INJUNCTION ORDER APPLIES TO THE LIQUIDATION INSTRUCTIONS COVERED BY MESSAGE NUMBER 7037201, DATED 02/06/2007; MESSAGE NUMBER 4341203 DATED 12/06/2004; AND MESSAGE NUMBER 6345205 DATED 12/11/2006. THIS INJUNCTION SUPERCEDES THE TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER MESSAGE NUMBER 7079205 DATED 03/20/2007.

5. EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, CBP IS INSTRUCTED TO PREVENT LIQUIDATION OF ANY ENTRIES SUBJECT TO THE ABOVE.

6. THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE WAS SERVED WITH THE ABOVE REFERENCED INJUNCTION ON 05/03/2007. PURSUANT TO THE TERMS OF THE INJUNCTION, NO LIQUIDATION OF THE ENTRIES COVERED BY THE INJUNCTION MAY BE MADE FOR ENTRIES WHICH REMAIN UNLIQUIDATED AS OF 5:00 P.M. THE FIFTH BUSINESS DAY ON WHICH THE COPIES OF THE ORDER WERE PERSONALLY SERVED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE.
