RE: SCOPE RULING ON PRESSURE SENSITIVE TAPE FROM ITALY  
(INCAS CORPORATION)

1. ON MARCH 18, 1992, IN RESPONSE TO A REQUEST BY INCAS CORPORATION (INCAS), THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE ISSUED A FINAL SCOPE RULING THAT "NOTETAPE", A DOCUMENT NOTE HIGHLIGHTING TAPE MANUFACTURED BY LEE PRODUCTS COMPANY, IS NOT WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY FINDING COVERING PRESSURE SENSITIVE TAPE FROM ITALY.

2. "NOTETAPE" IS A DOCUMENT NOTE HIGHLIGHTER THAT CAN ALSO BE WRITTEN UPON FOR EDITING DOCUMENTS. BECAUSE NOTETAPE HAS WEAK

BONDING PROPERTIES AND IS TRANSLUCENT, IT CANNOT BE USED FOR ANY OF THE PURPOSES SET-OUT IN THE ITC DETERMINATION. THEREFORE, THE DEPARTMENT FOUND THAT "NOTETAPE" IS NOT PRESSURE SENSITIVE TAPE WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE FINDING.

3. EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, TERMINATE SUSPENSION AND LIQUIDATE, WITHOUT REGARD TO ANTIDUMPING DUTIES, ALL UNLIQUIDATED ENTRIES OF THE PRODUCT LISTED IN PARAGRAPH 1, REGARDLESS OF ENTRY DATE.

4. REFUND DEPOSITS AND RELEASE ANY BONDS RELATING TO THE PRODUCT LISTED IN PARAGRAPH 1.

5. CONTINUE TO SUSPEND LIQUIDATION OF ALL OTHER ENTRIES OF PRESSURE SENSITIVE TAPE FROM ITALY SUBJECT TO THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY FINDING ON PRESSURE SENSITIVE TAPE FROM ITALY.
