RE: SCOPE RULING ON ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER ON PETROLEUM WAX CANDLES FROM THE PRC

1. ON SEPTEMBER 25, 1997, IN RESPONSE TO A REQUEST BY M.G. MAHER AND CO., INC. (M.G. MAHER), THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE ISSUED A FINAL SCOPE RULING THAT SPIRAL "FLAME" CANDLES ARE WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER COVERING PETROLEUM WAX CANDLES FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA (A-570-504).

2. BECAUSE THE IMPORTED PRODUCT IS A SPIRAL CANDLE MADE OF PETROLEUM WAX, THE COMMERCE DEPARTMENT FOUND THIS PRODUCT TO BE

WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE ORDER ON PETROLEUM WAX CANDLES FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA.

3. CONTINUE TO SUSPEND LIQUIDATION OF ENTRY SUMMARIES OF PETROLEUM WAX CANDLES FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA, INCLUDING M.G. MAHER'S SPIRAL CANDLE LISTED ABOVE, SUBJECT TO THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER COVERING PETROLEUM WAX CANDLES FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA.
