ON JANUARY 6, 1998, THE U.S. COURT OF INTERNATIONAL TRADE ISSUED A PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION ENJOINING LIQUIDATION OF ENTRY NUMBER 515-004-7967-3 OF JUNE 29, 1992 WHICH IS SUBJECT TO THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER ON SILICON METAL FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA (A-570-806) MANUFACTURED OR EXPORTED BY YUN MEI INTERNATIONAL TRADING, INC.

2. ACCORDINGLY, UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE, DO NOT LIQUIDATE ENTRY

NUMBER 515-004-7967-3 OF JUNE 29, 1992 WHICH WAS PRODUCED OR EXPORTED BY YUN MEI INTERNATIONAL TRADING, INC. CONTINUE TO SUSPEND LIQUIDATION OF OTHER ENTRY SUMMARIES UNTIL LIQUIDATION INSTRUCTIONS ARE PROVIDED.
