1. ON 12/02/1999, THE INTERNATIONAL TRADE COMMISSION (ITC) NOTIFIED THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE OF ITS NEGATIVE FINAL DETERMINATION IN THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATION OF DYNAMIC RANDOM ACCESS MEMORY SEMICONDUCTORS OF ONE MEGABIT OR ABOVE ("

DRAMS") FROM TAIWAN (A-471-222). THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATION OF DRAMS FROM TAIWAN HAS BEEN TERMINATED.

2. FIELD OFFICES SHOULD DISCONTINUE SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION

OF ALL SHIPMENTS OF THIS MERCHANDISE ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR AFTER 05/28/1999. ALL ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES DEPOSITED ON ENTRIES OF THE SUBJECT MERCHANDISE SHALL BE REFUNDED AND THE BONDS OR OTHER SECURITY RELEASED AT THE TIME OF LIQUIDATION.

3. INTEREST PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930 DO NOT APPLY.
