RE: Notice of a negative final determination in the countervailing duty investigation of certain frozen warmwater shrimp from Thailand (C-549-828)

1. On 08/19/2013, Commerce published in the Federal Register its negative final determination in the countervailing duty investigation of certain frozen warmwater shrimp from Thailand (78 FR 50379).
2. The products covered by this investigation are described in message 3032301 dated 02/01/2013.
3. This investigation has been assigned investigation number C-549-828.
4. Commerce found that de minimis countervailable subsidy rates of less than 2 percent exist with respect to certain frozen warmwater shrimp from Thailand. Accordingly, CBP is directed to terminate the suspension of liquidation for shipments of subject merchandise entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 06/04/2013, to release any bond or other security, and to refund any cash deposits. The interest provisions of section 778 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, do not apply.
5. Notice of the lifting of suspension of liquidation of entries of merchandise entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 06/04/2013 occurred with the publication of the notice of final determination of investigation (78 FR 50379, 08/19/2013).
