POWER MICROWAVE AMPLIFIERS AND COMPONENTS THEREOF FROM  
JAPAN (A-588-005)

1. AS A RESULT OF A NOTIFICATION FROM THE PETITIONER, MCL INC., THAT IT NO LONGER IS INTERESTED IN THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER ON HIGH POWER MICROWAVE AMPLIFIERS (HPMAS) WITH RESPECT TO TRAVELING WAVE TUBES (TWTS) AND KLYSTRON TUBES, TWO COMPONENTS OF HPMAS, THE COMMERCE DEPARTMENT HAS PARTIALLY REVOKED THIS ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER AND PUBLISHED THE PARTIAL REVOCATION IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER ON FEBRUARY 28, 1997.

2. THEREFORE, CUSTOMS IS DIRECTED TO TERMINATE THE SUSPENSION

OF LIQUIDATION FOR ALL SHIPMENTS OF TWTS AND KLYSTRON TUBES FROM JAPAN ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 1996 AND TO LIQUIDATE SUCH SUSPENDED ENTRY SUMMARIES WITHOUT REGARD TO ANTIDUMPING DUTIES.

3. THE ASSESSMENT OF ANTIDUMPING DUTIES BY THE CUSTOMS SERVICE ON ENTRIES OF THIS MERCHANDISE IS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930. SECTION 778 REQUIRES THAT CUSTOMS PAY INTEREST ON OVERPAYMENTS, OR ASSESS INTEREST ON UNDERPAYMENTS, OF THE REQUIRED AMOUNTS DEPOSITED AS ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES. THE INTEREST PROVISIONS ARE NOT APPLICABLE TO CASH OR BONDS POSTED AS ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES BEFORE THE DATE OF PUBLICATION OF THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER. INTEREST SHALL BE CALCULATED FROM THE DATE OF PAYMENT OF ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES THROUGH THE DATE OF LIQUIDATION. THE RATE AT WHICH SUCH INTEREST IS PAYABLE IS THE RATE IN EFFECT UNDER SECTION 6621 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1954 FOR SUCH PERIOD.

4.
